FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) is a free program that helps FoodShare members build their job skills and find jobs. Through FSET, they offer job skills training, education activities, interview skills, and members can get work experience. These skills will help members find a rewarding career. FSET will help members get a job after they learn their strengths, needs, and type of work preferred. They also will use information about jobs where members live to help plan career goals.

FSET provides support services to help members complete FSET activities including barriers to work. They'll help pay for things needed for FSET activities, such as work clothes, tools, books,

child care, gas vouchers, and more.
